



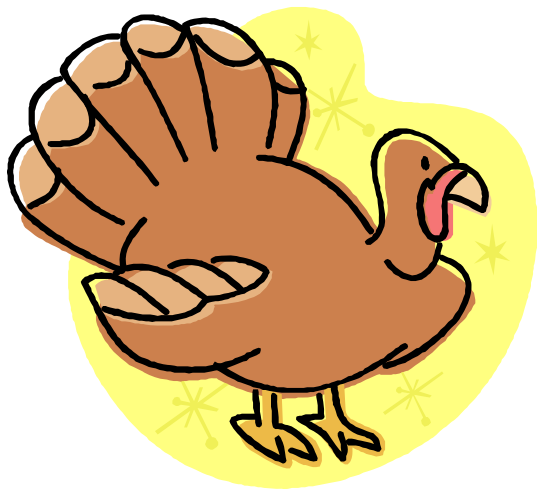

Gently Used Children's Book Drive - November 9 -20

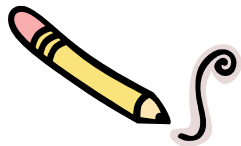
