- +Census data is used to determine location for retail stores, schools, hospitals and new housing.
- +Census data is not shared with the IRS, INS, or any other federal agencies, law enforcement entities, etc.
- +It only takes 10 minutes to complete.

This special unit reinforces various aspects of the fourth grade humanities strand: philosophical thinking.
