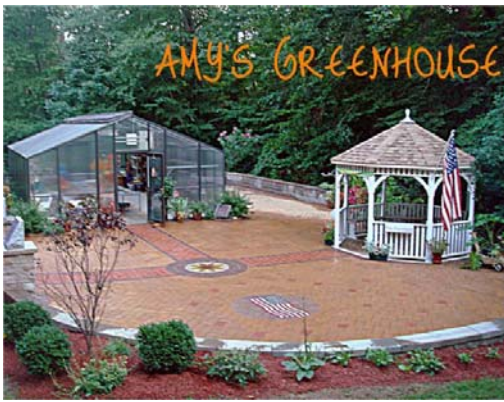
GOING GREEN—No Idling Campaign

Westchester County enacted a law that states that persons operating a motor vehicle are not permitted to let their engine idle for more than 3 consecutive minutes when the vehicle is not in motion. The purpose of this campaign is to reduce pollution from idling buses and cars that negatively affect our children's healthy lung growth and development. By not idling, you not only help the environment and instill a sense of environmental responsibility in your children, you save money. Idling for 30 seconds uses more fuel than restarting your engine, and idling for only 10 minutes per day wastes an average of 24.6 gallons of gas yearly.

On September 11, 2009 the Amy's Greenhouse committee hosted a memorial ceremony to honor the memory of Amy O'Doherty who perished in the World Trade Center attacks on 9/11, and pay tribute to first responders.

In attendance were Mayor Bramson and representatives from the New Rochelle fire department and the Sound Shore Medical Center's Emergency Room team.

Millie Radonjic led the pledge and announced the surprise installation of a beautiful, custom made American flag mosaic in the center of the patio donated by US Airways flight attendant, Marianne Moore.

Eleven new bricks were also revealed, including one donated by US Airways flight attendants

in honor of Captain Sully, the Hero on the Hudson.

Danny Ilich, Kiwanis Foundation trustee, and K-Club members presented pediatric trauma and oxygen kits to the New Rochelle Fire Commissioner and to the Sound Shore Emergency Room director.

These donations were intended to honor the contributions of the 9/11 first responders and will provided much needed equipment to help protect our children in emergency situations. Each kit contains life saving equipment that is sized to fit and more effectively treat patients from infants to teens.

In closing the ceremony, Amy's sister Maura tearfully thanked everyone for coming and remembering her sister. She expressed that the greenhouse at Barnard was helping to keep Amy's memory alive and that it comforted her to know that her sister's name continued to be spoken so often by so many.
